CCHS SPONSORING LOW COST SPAY/NEUTER PROGRAM

Breese--The Clinton County Humane Society (CCHS) is currently sponsoring a low cost Spay/Neuter Program for dogs and cats of low income folks in Clinton County.

Spay and neuter procedures will cost only \$50 per pet; “pitbulls” will be done for free at the discretion of the veterinarian and CCHS.

Applications will be available at the CCHS office a 1301 Apple Lane in Breese, at the Carlyle Animal Hospital in Carlyle, at Crooked Creek Animal Hospital on Shattuc Road, and at Veterinary Services LTD in Breese.

Applicants must be residents of Clinton County who currently receive low income assistance or have proof of low income.

Once the application and proof of low income eligibility have been approved, the applicant will receive a voucher to take with a \$50 payment to the veterinarian in order to receive the service.

Veterinary records for the dog or cat must be presented at the time of surgery.

Animals must be free of fleas and ticks or will be charged accordingly for any treatment required.

Procedures must be performed at one of the three participating veterinarians previously listed.

Active breeders are NOT eligible for this program.

CCHS is dedicated to helping educate people about the need to spay and neuter pets to help control the numbers of unwanted pets.
