PET CONNECTION—Meet Krakatoa!



This big handsome fella is a 4-year-old German Shepherd mix. He is a playful guy, who doesn't realize how big he is sometimes. He would be best suited for someone who is experienced with the breed and who has time to train him. Krakatoa has a huge play drive and seems very willing to please. He is good on leash, crate-trained (though he doesn't like to be in a crate), kennel trained and housebroken. He loves to go for a ride! He stays close when he is loose. He is okay with other dogs, cats and kids. Krakatoa was treated for heartworm when he came in and had to be shaved because he was so matted. He will have a longer coat when it finishes growing out. He is vet checked, up to date on shots, spayed/neutered, and micro-chipped. If you are looking for a big bundle of energy, call CCHS at 526-4500 to set up an appointment to meet him. You can fill out an adoption application online at www.ccilhs.org and email it or pick up an application at the building. If you later decide not to adopt, you are not obligated.

CCHS has other wonderful pets available including cat **Amelia**, gray/wt; and kittens **Pippy**, gray; **Tossy**, white/orange; **Cosmo**, gray tabby; **Pooter** and **Mosley**, gray/wt; **Petunia**, buff/white; and new kittens **Jordan** and **Sam**, orange/white. Most of the cats reside at the CCHS building at 1301 Apple Lane where folks can visit them daily from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m. and weekdays from 5:30 p.m. until 7:30 p.m.

Available dogs include **Bella**, Staffie; **Muff**, Yorkie/Terrier; **Flash**, Staffie mix; **Charley** and **Harley**, Black Labs; **Krakatoa** and **Skip**, Shepherd mixes; **Frank**, Australian Shepherd mix; and puppies **Willie**, **Wynona**, **Crystal**, Shepherd mixes.

Stop by the CCHS facility at 1301 Apple Lane in Breese to check out the sale merchandise. Adult tees cost only \$12; youth tees, \$8; 2012 Lucky Dog Family Reunion tees, \$5; and adult hoodies, \$15, just in time for fall.

The store also carries pet collars, leashes, toys and much more, as well as other CCHS logo apparel for people from onesies to 3X.

Meet and Greets are held the first and third Saturdays each month. The next Meet and Greet will be Saturday, Oct 5, at the Carlyle Healthcare Center from 10 a.m. until noon. Micro-chipping for your pet will be available for \$25, including registration.

The next regular CCHS meeting will be held Wednesday, Oct 9, at 7 p.m. at the CCHS facility at 1301 Apple Lane. Meetings are open to the public and new members are always welcome.

If your health, finances or housing make it necessary for you to surrender your pet, CCHS may be able to help.

Call the CCHS at 526-4500 to start the process.

You must provide your pet's medical history from your vet, a photo and a completed surrender application with information about your pet's personality and training, and your pet will be tested for adoptability.

If all goes well, he will be added to the CCHS roster, and the search for his new family will begin.

There is no charge for surrendering your pet.
