Residents from the center had a chance to meet the pets in the Sun Room, while Jasmine toured the building with her handler Brandy Kessel meeting residents.





## PET TAG/ MICRO-CHIP MAY BRING YOUR LOST PET HOME QUICKLY

An ID tag is one way to improve the chances of your getting your pet back if he gets lost.

If your pet wanders off and is wearing a tag with his name and your phone number, all it will take to get him home is a phone call.

His collar and tags could be lost, so an even better way to get him home is to micro-chip him.

This tiny implant carries a number to identify your pet so the company where the chip is registered will contact you if your pet turns up at a vet, shelter or the police.

CCHS offers both tags and micro-chipping!
